Application Processing:

- Enrollment is determined by a drawing.
- The Church Member drawing will take place on Tuesday, February 14 at 6 p.m.
- Church Member applications received after 6 p.m. on February 14 will be included in the community drawing.
- The Community drawing will take place on Friday, February 17 at 6 p.m.
- ALL applications received after 6 p.m. on Friday February 17 will be processed in order of receipt.

Registration Instructions:

- 1. Complete two-page Application for Enrollment. Fill in all blanks (use "none" or "N/A" when appropriate). Incomplete forms will not be processed.
- 2. Submit **one check per application** for the **Gesell Fee only**. Be sure to indicate your desired hours (part-time or full-time).
- 3. If you have two or more children, place applications in the **same envelope**. This is VERY IMPORTANT!
- 4. We encourage hand-delivery. If you choose to mail; please select a method that you can track, e.g., return receipt.
- 5. You will be contacted by March 10 to schedule a Gesell Developmental Screening for your child. Upon receipt of the Gesell results, acceptance and waiting list letters will be mailed.
- 6. If your child is accepted in the program **before May 1**, the Registration Fee and September Tuition are due and are not refundable. If your child is accepted in the program **after May 1**, Registration Fee, September and May 2018 Tuition are due and are **not refundable** once paid.
- 7. In order to hold your child's place in our program, the May 2018 Advance Tuition is due on or before May 1, 2017, and is not refundable once paid.
- 8. St. Luke's Day School requires written notification to decline enrollment or withdraw your child from the school.

All applications are subject the approval of Debbie Weymouth, Director of Day School. Registration is open to all children regardless of race, ethnic origin, or religious preference.

St. Luke's Day School Registration Procedures 2017-2018 School Year

Registration Priority Order:

- 1. Currently enrolled students children who are enrolled for the 2016-2017 school year
- 2. Siblings new siblings of currently enrolled students
- 3. Church members new applicants having at least one parent that is a member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church
- 4. Community new applicants that do not have a current connection to the school or church

Currently Enrolled Students and Siblings:

- 1. Re-enrollment applications will be distributed through the classrooms the week of January 16.
- 2. Applications for new siblings should be picked up in the Day School office the same week.
- 3. Forms for all children in the family who are applying for the 2017-18 school year should be placed in the **same envelope**. This is very important in determining the order of processing!
- 4. Parents may turn in forms and payment to the Day School office upon receipt. Forms turned in **by 6 p.m. on Monday, February 6** will be placed in a drawing to determine order of processing; forms turned in after 6 p.m. on February 6 will be processed in order of receipt. Currently enrolled priority ends Monday, February 13 at 6 p.m.
- 5. Returning students have 1st priority: processing begins after the drawing on February 6 at 6 p.m. Siblings of currently enrolled students have 2nd priority: processing begins Monday, February 13.

New Families:

- 1. We strongly recommend that you attend a school tour if you have not done so previously. Tours take place at 9:30 a.m. on January 24, January 31, February 7, and February 16. Please visit our website at www.stlukesdayschool.org to reserve a spot for a tour.
- 2. Forms for all children in the family who are applying for the 2017-18 school year should be placed in the **same envelope**. This is very important in determining the order of processing!
- 3. **Church Members**: Turn in completed application and check to the Day School office **by 6 p.m. on Tuesday, February 14**. Order of processing will be determined by a drawing. Applications received after February 14 will be included in the community drawing on February 17. ALL applications received after February 17 will be processed in order of receipt.
- 4. **Community**: Turn in completed application and check to the Day School office **by 6 p.m. on Friday, February 17**. Order of processing will be determined by a drawing. ALL applications received after February 17 will be processed in order of receipt.
- 5. If your child has been on the waiting list previously, you must **reapply** for the 2017-18 school year. We do not carry the waiting list over to the next school year.

Notification for all applicants:

- 1. **Acceptance and waiting list letters will be mailed** to the parents of applicants **by Friday, March 10**. We cannot guarantee your first choice, or that all children will be accepted in the program.
- 2. If your child is accepted into the program, your check will be deposited in mid-March after the letters are mailed. The **Registration Fee is not refundable**. Parents have until Friday, March 31, 2017 to decline enrollment and receive a tuition refund. **After March 31**, the tuition deposit is not refundable.
- 3. If your child is placed on the waiting list, your check will be returned. We use the waiting list to fill openings as they occur through January 2018. The waiting list does not carry over to the next school year. Remember to re-apply for the 2018-2019 school year if you haven't heard from us by January 2018.
