Child participates in group prayer during Chapel, meal, and snack times

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Self-awareness/body placement
- Language & communication skills
- Imitates prayerful adult
- Self-confidence

Developmental Milestones: Spiritual

Child sings Chapel songs and begins to use hand motions

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Beginning worship participation
- Expression of spiritual vocabulary (verbal or signed)
- Thinking about God
- Interpersonal communication through speaking and singing
- Self-confidence

Developmental Milestones: Spiritual

Child listens to simple Bible stories

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Spiritual literacy awareness; Bible knowledge
- Thinking about God
- Listening
- Receptive language processing

Developmental Milestones: Spiritual

Child begins to talk about God and Jesus

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Thinking about *God/Jesus*
- Beginning to repeat ideas/stories learned in Chapel
- Learning about faith rituals
- Expression of spiritual vocabulary
- Self-confidence

Developmental Milestones: Spiritual

Child is showing an interest in God's beautiful world

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Basic environmental vocabulary - names of familiar animals, plants, etc.
- Respect and care for animals and plants
- Caring language & communication
- Beginning to relate Bible stories and/or Bible verses to everyday life

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Language & communication
- Spiritual awareness
- Learning about faith rituals
- Expression of spiritual vocabulary (verbal or signed)
