Child begins to imitate peers and/or adult actions

These observations involve the following developmental skills:

- Consistent focus/attention span
- Self-confidence
- Emotional & social responsiveness
- Memory recall; observation skills

Child brings familiar people their shoes or other personal objects

- Attachment
- Thinking, reasoning, and problem-solving

Child feeds doll or stuffed animal with pretend bottle or food
